Read a book or listen to an audiobook. Next, use these guidelines and printables to have fun with your imagination!

1. Choose one of your favorite characters from the story and pretend you are friends with that character.

- Write a friendly letter to tell your friend about your plans for Thanksgiving.
- Invite him or her to join you for Thanksgiving.
- Use the stationery provided or create your own.

2. Tell your friend (the book character) how to get to your location!

- If you know the location of the character in the story, make that your starting point.
- Draw a line from that point to your location.
- What if the character is not located in the United States? Color the state in which you will be so the character can fly there!

3. Make a Thanksgiving menu featuring foods you would like to serve to your friend.

4. What did you eat? Draw your meal. What did your friend choose to eat? Draw your friend's meal.

5. How was the book character described in the story?

- Pretend you took a picture of your friend while he or she visited. Use the picture frame to draw a picture of the book character.

6. Make a list of things for which you are thankful. Think about the story. What do you think your friend would write? Make a list for your friend.

7. Write a diary entry about your Thanksgiving. What would your friend write? Write a diary entry for your friend.

8. Draw some of your favorite scenes from the story.

9. Send a thank-you note to your Thanksgiving host/hostess.

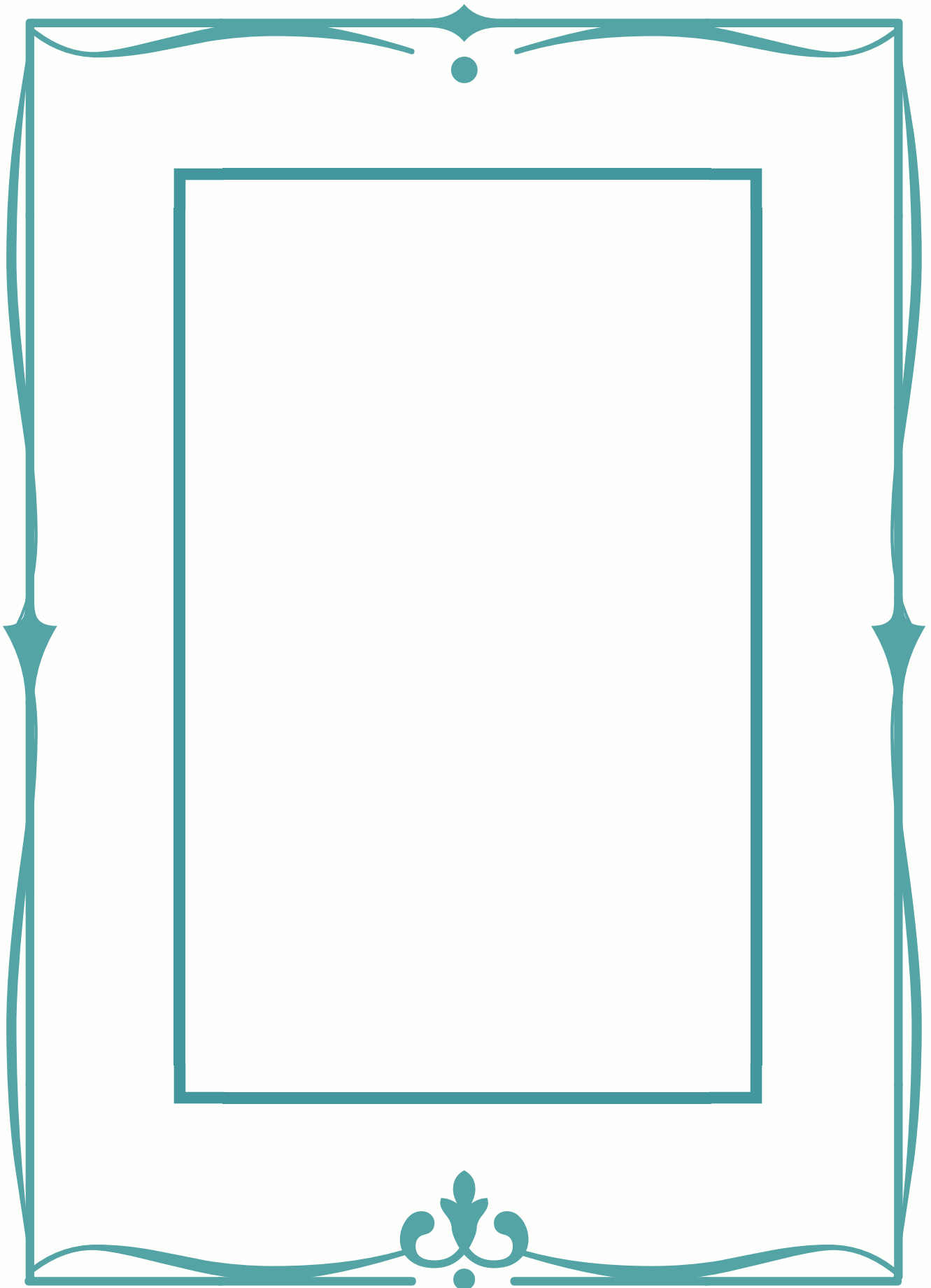

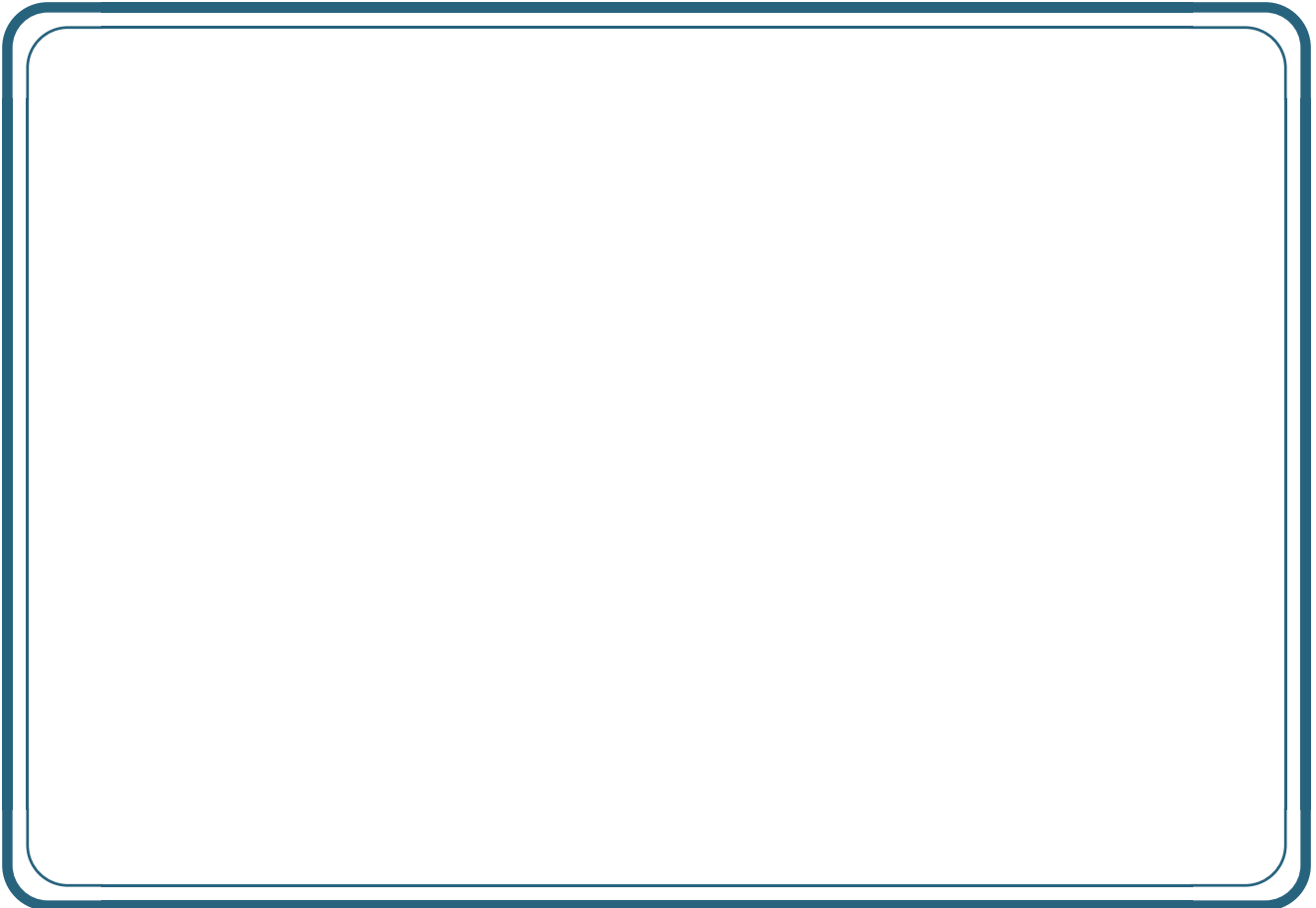
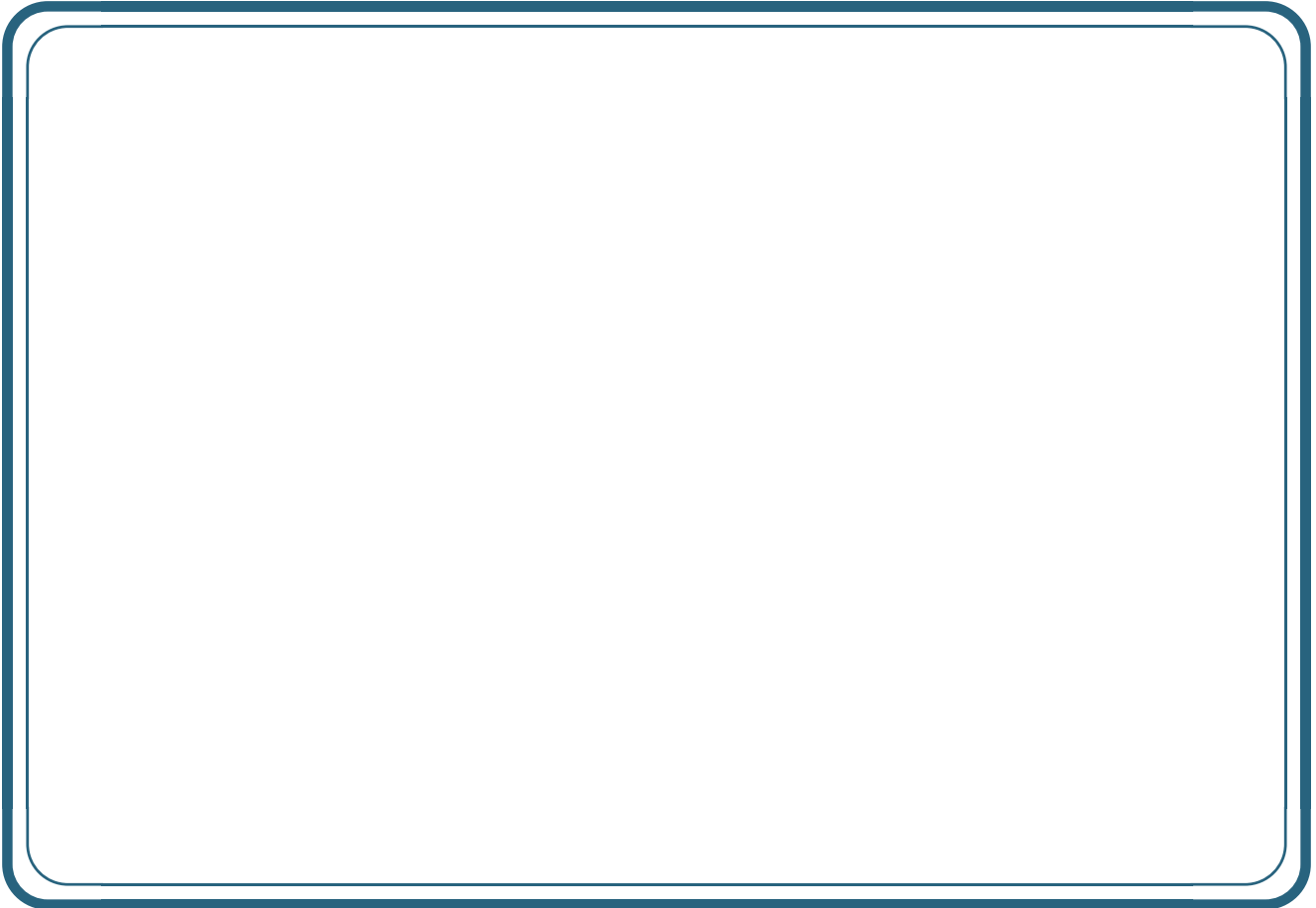
